 - (2). In Verses 9 and 10a, “repentance” occurs twice with the same Greek word, “metanoia”, and means what? “A change of mind.”
 - (3). In Verse 10b, “repented” is the Greek word “ametameletos”, and means what? Irrevocable.
6. True repentance is a change of mind that will lead to a change of action or a change in your living. True or False? False.
