 - (3). In I Corinthians 10:4, we are told that this rock is whom? *Jesus Christ*.
 - (4). The "church" spoken of in this verse is not speaking of what? <u>The local church.</u> But, rather, the Spiritual Body of Christ.

- (5). The church is spoken of and likened unto a building. The cornerstone of that building, or church, in Ephesians 2:19-22 is whom? *Christ*, not *Peter*.
- (6). The foundation of Christ's church was made up of whom? *Apostles and Prophets*, not *Peter*.
- (7). The church likened unto a building is continually being built by one stone after another. Who are these "stones?" *Every person that accepts Christ as his Savior*.
- (8). Catholicism claims Peter was their first Pope from Rome. There are two reasons that disprove this false claim. Name them:

- 26. Why were those baptized by John the Baptist? <u>As a testimony of their faith that Jesus Christ would be crucified and risen again as their Messiah.</u>
- 27. Why are we baptized today? *As a public profession of our faith in the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ as payment for our sins.*
- 28. Explain Acts 22:16. "And now why tarriest thou? Arise, and be baptized and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord." *His baptism showed that he was now a Christian and his sins of persecuting Christians would never be repeated again.*
- 29. What Scripture shows that Paul was to preach the Gospel for Salvation, and not baptism for salvation? *I Corinthians 1:17*.
- 30. Transubstantiation is practiced by what church? *Roman Catholic*.
- 31. Define "transubstantiation." *The ritual of mass which turns the bread and wine into the literal body and blood of Christ.*
