(1) Mutations – Your genes, which determine your race, color of hair, size, looks, ect.
Inherited from your parents.

(2) Transmutation – The changing of one species into another. Held by the Evolutionists.

5. The Greek word “anthropos” is where we get our English word describing the Science of Anthropology, meaning man.

6. What Scripture disproves Evolution by showing that all humans have one common origin of blood that differs from animals? Acts 17:26.

7. It was Charles Darwin, himself, that stated “There has never been found one species that has ever been transformed into another. Where is this? Life and Letters, Volume I, pp. 210.

8. What scientific evidence is there that fixes the species so that one species cannot pass over into another? The chromosomes within each cell.
9. What is the difference between the constitutional make up of man and animals?
 - (1). Man – Has a body, soul, and spirit.
 - (2). Animals - Have a body and soul, but no spirit.
10. What happens to a person’s soul and spirit at death? It leaves the body and is present in Heaven or Hell.
11. What happens to the soul of an animal when it dies? It dies with the body.
12. In Genesis 2:7, God said “He formed man out of the dust of the ground.” What is meant by that statement? 14 of the chemical elements are found in man’s body.
13. What is the Soul within a person? The seat of his emotions and appetites.

28. What was God’s purpose in forbidding Adam and Eve to abstain from eating of the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil? No reason, except to test their obedience.
29. True or False? When we sin we become a sinner? False.
30. Why did God allow Adam and Eve to be tempted by Satan? To prove his faithfulness before he could be promoted.
