34. In Isaiah 14:12 we read, “How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning.” The NASB (New American Standard Bible) and the NIV (New International Version Bible) have omitted “Lucifer” and put what instead? Morning Star.
35. The Hebrew word for “star” is “KOKAB”, so how do we know this is a perverted translation? The Hebrew word appears nowhere in any Hebrew manuscript we have.
36. How do we know these two Bibles purposely mistranslated this verse, by mistranslating Lucifer? Because they translated the Hebrew for “star” correctly in Job 38:7.
