15. B.F. Westcott (1825-1901) and F.J.A. Hort (1828-1892) came out with their corrupt "New Greek Testament, which is the foundation of all new versions. This came out when? 1881
16. Explain the so-called contradiction between Numbers 25:9, which states "*And those that died in the plague were twenty and four thousand (24,000);*" BUT, Paul in 1 Corinthians 10:8 states, "*Neither let us commit fornication, as some of them committed, and fell in one day three and twenty thousand. (23,000).*" 23,000 died in one day, and 24,000 died in the whole plague.
17. Explain the so-called contradiction. In Genesis 15:13 it states that Israel shall serve the Egyptians 400 years; BUT, Exodus 12:41 says that they were in Egypt 430 years.
Genesis 15:13 gives the number of years not afflicted (30), while Exodus 12 gives the total number of years in Egypt. (430).
18. Explain the so-called contradiction. In John 19:14,15, Christ was before Pilate at about the 6th Hour; BUT, in Matthew 27:44,45, Christ was on the Cross at the 6th Hour. How can He be in two places at once? Matthew, Mark and Luke use the Jewish time from 6:00 P.M. to 6:00 A.M., while John uses the Roman time from 12:00 P.M. to 12:00 A.M., or, Midnight to Noon.
